**(Principal) SONAR TECH**      Female      28- 35

306 - A SONAR TECHNICIAN with LOTS OF CHARACTER. She's really comfortable out on the open water, and is an expert at using this hightech piece of underwater detection equipment. It's just another day at the office for her, and she's very nonchalant about her work.

**(Principal) EVIDENCE CLERK**      Male      25-30

**(Actor) DRIVER**      Male      40 -50

**(Actor) VICTIM**      Female      50 -59

304 A MIDDLE-AGED WOMAN who suffers a vicious attack when taking money out of an ATM. She is VISIBLY SHAKEN, and was lucky in that she wasn't severely injured in the assault.

**(Actor) CLERK**      Either      20 -40

305 A CASHIER working at a CONVENIENCE STORE on Thanksgiving. The clerk sells DELORME a couple of sad looking microwave dinners.
